Connick (HB 1075) Act No. 100

<u>New law</u> adds cigarettes, cigarette butts, cigars, cigarillos, and cigar or cigarillo tips to the definition of litter in <u>existing law</u>.

<u>New law</u> increases the penalties for the intentional disposal or permitting the disposal of cigarettes, cigarette butts, cigars, cigarillos, and cigar or cigarillo tips from a motor vehicle as follows:

- (1) Changes the first offense <u>from</u> \$250 <u>to</u> \$300; retains eight hours of community service in a litter abatement program.
- (2) Changes the second offense <u>from</u> \$500 <u>to</u> \$700; retains 16 hours of community service in a litter abatement program.
- (3) Changes the third and subsequent offense <u>from</u> \$1,250 <u>to</u> \$1,500; retains 80 hours of community service in a litter abatement program and suspension of driver's license for one year.

Effective August 1, 2014.
