Henry (HB 514) Act No. 176

<u>New law</u> prohibits the sale, purchase, or attempt to purchase products containing dextromethorphan by minors.

New law provides penalties for selling a product containing dextromethorphan as follows:

- (1) First offense a fine of not more than \$50.
- (2) Second offense a fine of not more than \$100.
- (3) Third offense and any subsequent offense a fine of not more than \$150.

Provides that whoever violates <u>new law</u> by purchasing or attempting to purchase nonprescription products containing dextromethorphan, its salts or optical isomers, or salts of optical isomers shall be fined not more than \$50 for a first violation and not more than \$200 for a second or subsequent violation.

Provides that <u>new law</u> supersedes and preempts any local ordinances regulating the sales of products containing dextromethorphan.

Effective August 1, 2014.
