## **EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION**

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental expenditures as a result of this measure.

## **REVENUE EXPLANATION**

The proposed legislation will not have an overall impact on statutorily dedicated funds to the Utility and Carrier Inspection and Supervision Fund. Raising the inspection and supervision fees from \$0.59 to \$0.63.5 per \$1,000 of gross receipts for motor carriers and public utilities with gross receipts exceeding \$100 million per year will generate an estimated \$250,000 per year. Exempting nonprofit water utility cooperatives or corporations wholly owned by water user members from inspection and supervision fees will decrease statutorily dedicated funds to the Utility and Carrier Inspection and Supervision Fund by an estimated \$250,000 per year. The net impact of both fee changes will not have an overall impact on inspection and supervision fees going to the Utility and Carrier Inspection Fund.
