

Existing law, relative to the Vidalia Port Commission, requires commission members to be residents of the town of Vidalia. Provides for staggered terms for the initially appointed commissioners. Thereafter, provides for six- year terms for successor appointments.

New law changes the residency requirement to the parish of Concordia and increases the membership of the commission from five to seven members. Also changes the term of successor appointments from six-year to four-year terms.

Effective Aug. 1, 2014.
