

Existing law provides general exemptions from seizure under any writ, mandate, or process for specified income or property of a debtor.

Prior law included the debtor's arms and military accoutrements in the list of properties exempt from seizure.

New law specifies that all of the debtor's firearms, arms and ammunition, and accessories thereto, not exceeding a total maximum value of \$2,500, are exempt from seizure.

Prior law provided an exemption from seizure of one firearm necessary for the exercise of a trade, calling, or profession with a maximum value of \$500.

New law repeals prior law.
