Lopinto (HB 331) Act No. 551

<u>Existing law</u> authorizes the following persons to withdraw blood and administer chemical tests to determine the blood alcohol content or the presence of abused or illegal substances: physicians, physician assistants, registered nurses, emergency medical technicians, chemists, nurse practitioners, or other qualified technicians.

<u>New law</u> retains <u>existing law</u> and authorizes licensed practical nurses to withdraw blood and administer such tests.

<u>New law</u> provides that licensed practical nurses shall only withdraw blood as authorized by <u>new law</u> pursuant to a subpoena or court order.
