Broadwater (HB 244)

<u>Existing law provides with respect to the authority of a postsecondary education management</u> board to grant leases of immovable property under its supervision and management.

<u>New law</u> provides that if property at a public postsecondary education institution is leased to a nonprofit corporation or association for the purpose of holding a fundraising event, the lease may authorize and provide for the auction and sale of firearms at the event. Further provides that any such lease shall include at a minimum the following conditions:

- (1) The firearms to be auctioned are exhibited in a static display.
- (2) Campus security is present at the event.
- (3) The event shall be held indoors.
- (4) The firearms to be auctioned are equipped with a safety lock or other safety feature that renders the firearm nonoperational.

<u>Existing law</u> provides that carrying a firearm or dangerous weapon at a school-sponsored function or in a firearm-free zone is unlawful. <u>Existing law</u> provides for certain exceptions. <u>New law</u> adds an event held pursuant to <u>new law</u> to list of exceptions.
