Abstract: Adds to types of service eligible to be considered in computing of prior service for purposes of receiving state supplemental pay for municipal police and deputy sheriffs.

<u>Present law</u> provides for state supplemental pay of \$500 per month for full-time municipal police officers and deputy sheriffs who have completed one year of service. For municipal law enforcement officers, <u>present law</u> allows prior service as a deputy sheriff or as a certain type of retired state police officer to count towards the one year of service requirement. For deputy sheriffs, <u>present law</u> allows prior service as a municipal police officer, an enforcement agent of the Dept. of Wildlife and Fisheries, or certain retired state police officers to count towards the one year of service requirement.

<u>Proposed law</u> expands prior service for municipal law enforcement officers to include service as a P.O.S.T.-certified law enforcement officer employed full-time by the Dept. of Wildlife and Fisheries or the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections to count towards the one year of service requirement.

<u>Proposed law</u> expands prior service for deputy sheriffs to include service as a P.O.S.T.-certified officer of the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections to count towards the one year of service requirement.
