Abstract: Requires an internal auditing function for postsecondary education and departments in the executive branch of state government with an appropriation of \$30 million or more.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires that the Board of Regents, the Louisiana Student Financial Assistance Commission, each postsecondary education management board, and the undersecretary, as defined in <u>proposed law</u>, of each department in the executive branch of state government with an appropriation of \$30 million or more establish an internal auditing function and a chief audit executive that will be responsible for adhering to the Institute of Internal Auditors, International Standards for the Professional Practice of Internal Auditing.

<u>Present law</u> provides that one of the duties of the Department of Environmental Quality, executive office of the secretary is to provide internal audits.

<u>Proposed law</u> deletes <u>present law</u> due to the internal audit requirements of the undersecretary in <u>proposed law</u>.
