Abstract: Authorizes the state veterinarian to place any animal in quarantine until the necessary inspections, tests, or epidemiological investigations have been completed.

<u>Present law</u> authorizes the state veterinarian to place livestock in quarantine until the necessary inspections, tests, or epidemiological investigations have been completed. <u>Proposed law</u> expands the authority to quarantine in <u>present law</u> to any animal.
