2	To enact R.S. 37:695.1, relative to engineers; to provide for powers and duties of the
3	Louisiana Professional Engineering and Land Surveying Board; to provide for
4	qualifications; to provide for waivers of certain requirements; to provide certain
5	procedures and conditions; and to provide for related matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 37:695.1 is hereby enacted to read as follows:
8	§695.1. Waiver of the fundamentals of engineering exam
9	A.(1) For good cause, the board may waive the fundamentals of
10	engineering exam.
11	(2) When a fundamentals of engineering exam waiver is sought by an
12	applicant, the board in making its determination whether to waive the exam
13	shall consider relevant factors that include but are not limited to the following:
14	(a) The applicant's education.
15	(b) The applicant's work experience.
16	(c) Whether the applicant is licensed in any other state and the status of
17	such license.

1	(d) Whether another state's licensing authority has initiated a
2	disciplinary proceeding against the applicant and the outcome of such
3	proceeding.
4	(e) Whether the applicant has had a license denied, revoked, or
5	suspended by another licensing authority.
6	B. The board shall adopt rules in accordance with the Administrative
7	Procedure Act to implement the provisions of this Section by December 1, 2015.

Martiny

Present law provides for qualifications of professional engineers in La.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and authorizes the La. Professional Engineering and Land Surveying Board ("board") to waive the fundamentals of engineering exam for good cause.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that when a waiver is sought by an applicant, the board in making its determination whether to waive the examination shall consider relevant factors that include but are not limited to the following:

(1) The applicant's education.

- (2) The applicant's work experience.
- (3) Whether the applicant is licensed in any other state and the status of such license.
- (4) Whether another state's licensing authority has initiated a disciplinary proceeding against the applicant and the outcome of such proceeding.
- (5) Whether the applicant has had a license denied, revoked, or suspended by another licensing authority.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that the board shall adopt rules in accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act to implement the provisions of <u>proposed law</u> by December 1, 2015.

Effective August 1, 2015.
