Abstract: Provides for limited exemplary damages in actions for injury caused by acts of terror.

<u>Proposed law</u> authorizes the award of exemplary damages in addition to general and special damages for up to three times the amount of actual damages or \$10,000, whichever is greater, for an action only against the terrorist for injury caused to a person or person's property by wanton and reckless disregard through acts of terror or terrorism.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the prevailing party to be awarded court costs and attorney fees and provides that the remedies provided for in <u>proposed law</u> are in addition to any other rights and remedies.

Proposed law provides for a five-year prescriptive period.

Proposed law provides for the definition of "act of terror" or "terrorism" and "terrorist".
