TAX/SALES & USE: Suspends all state sales and use tax exemptions

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION 2 To suspend until sixty days after final adjournment of the 2016 Regular Session of the 3 Legislature of Louisiana the exemptions for the tax levied pursuant to R.S. 47:302, 4 321, and 331. 5 WHEREAS, whenever the condition of the state fisc permits, the Legislature of 6 Louisiana has attempted to afford tax relief to its citizenry in the form of various exemptions 7 from the sales and use tax; and WHEREAS, the financial condition of the state is such that monies lost due to these 8 9 exemptions are critically needed to avoid cessation of vital services to the citizens of the 10 state. 11 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana hereby suspends 12 all of the exemptions from the tax levied pursuant to R.S. 47:302, 321, and 331. 13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this suspension shall become effective upon 14 adoption of this Resolution and shall extend through the sixtieth day after final adjournment 15 of the 2016 Regular Session of the Legislature of Louisiana.
