Riser

Present law provides for the number of assistant district attorneys for the various judicial districts.

<u>Proposed law</u> increases the number of assistant district attorneys in particular judicial districts as follows:

- (1) 5th JDC <u>from</u> 6 <u>to</u> 7.
- (2) 6^{th} JDC from 7 to 8.
- (2) 7th JDC from 5 to 6.
- (3) 14th JDC from 23 to 24.
- (4) 16th JDC from 21 to 22.
- (5) 19th JDC from 48 to 50.
- (6) 20th JDC from 5 to 6.
- (7) 21^{st} JDC from 18 to 19.
- (8) 24th JDC from 52 to 54.
- (9) 29th JDC from 9 to 10.
- (10) 36th JDC from 4 to 5.
- (11) 37th JDC from 2 to 3.

Effective on August 1, 2015, provided that funding for the additional 14 assistant district attorney positions is appropriated and payable out of the state general fund in the general appropriation bill for the state.
