2	To amend and reenact R.S. 51:2361(A)(2) and to repeal R.S. 47:6014(E), relative to special
3	treasury funds; to provide for the transfer, dedication, use, and appropriations as
4	specified of certain treasury funds; to provide for the deposit of certain funds into the
5	state treasury; to provide for deposits into the Rapid Response Fund; to repeal the
6	Telephone Company Property Assessment Relief Fund; to authorize the transfer of
7	balances between funds; and to provide for related matters.
8	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
9	Section 1. R.S. $51:2361(A)(2)$ is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
10	§2361. Rapid Response Fund

13	(2) Beginning July 1, 2005, the state treasurer is directed to deposit into the
14	fund at the beginning of each fiscal year an amount sufficient to bring the
15	unencumbered balance in the fund to ten million dollars. The legislature may
16	appropriate additional monies to the fund notwithstanding the balance in the fund.

18	Section 2. (A) Effective June 30, 2015, R.S. 47:6014(E) is hereby repealed in its
19	entirety.

1	(B) Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the state treasurer is
2	hereby authorized and directed to transfer the fund balance of the Telephone Company
3	Property Assessment Relief Fund at the end of Fiscal Year 2014-2015 to the Overcollections
4	Fund.
5	Section 3.(A) Notwithstanding any provision of the law to the contrary, the state
6	treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to transfer the following amounts into the
7	Overcollections Fund from the funds specified below:
8	(1) Fifteen Million Dollars from the Insurance Verification Fund.
9	(2) Nine Million Three Hundred Twenty-Six Thousand Nine Hundred Seventy-Eight
10	Dollars from the Riverboat Gaming Enforcement Fund.
11	(3) Three Million Five Hundred Forty Thousand Dollars from the Employment
12	Security Administration Account of the Employment Security Administration Fund.
13	(4) Four Million Two Hundred Thousand Dollars from the Penalty and Interest
14	Account of the Employment Security Administration Fund.
15	(B) Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the state treasurer is
16	hereby authorized and directed to transfer Twelve Million Dollars from the Self-Insurance
17	Fund to the Overcollections Fund.
18	(C) Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the state treasurer is
19	hereby authorized and directed to transfer Eleven Million One Hundred Thousand Dollars
20	from the Department of Revenue to the Overcollections Fund.
21	(D) Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the Louisiana Office
22	Building Corporation or its successor is hereby authorized and directed to deposit into the
23	state treasury Five Hundred Thousand Dollars. The state treasurer is hereby authorized and
24	directed to transfer the funds to the Overcollections Fund.
25	(E) Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the Louisiana Public
26	Facilities Authority or its successor is hereby authorized and directed to deposit into the state
27	treasury Twenty Million Dollars. The state treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to
28	transfer the funds to the Overcollections Fund.

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1	Section 4. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the Louisiana
2	Lottery Corporation or it successor is hereby authorized and directed to deposit into the state
3	treasury the unrestricted or unencumbered fund assets of Five Million Nine Hundred
4	Thousand Dollars. The state treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to transfer the funds
5	to the Lottery Proceeds Fund.
6	Section 5. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the state treasurer
7	is hereby authorized and directed to transfer Forty-Four Million Six Hundred Twenty-Seven
8	Thousand Eight Hundred Ninety-Two Dollars, to be comprised wholly of nonrecurring
9	revenues out of the state general fund from the Fiscal Year 2013-2014 surplus, as recognized
10	by the Revenue Estimating Conference, to the Budget Stabilization Fund.
11	Section 6. Sections 2, 3, 4, 6, and 7 of this Act shall become effective upon signature
12	of this Act by the governor or, if not signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for
13	bills to become law without signature by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section
14	18 of the Constitution of Louisiana.
15	Section 7. Sections 1 and 5 of this Act shall become effective on July 1, 2015.

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Abstract: Provides for the transfer and deposit of monies among state funds, including deposits into the Overcollections Fund, the Lottery Proceeds Fund, and the Budget Stabilization Fund.

TELEPHONE COMPANY PROPERTY ASSESSMENT RELIEF FUND (EFFECTIVE GOV'S SIGNATURE)

<u>Proposed law</u> repeals <u>present law</u> effective June 30, 2015, which creates the Telephone Company Property Assessment Relief Fund, allocates a portion of the sales tax on interstate and international telecommunications into the fund, and transfers money out of the fund to pay credits taken and refunds issued for property taxes paid by certain telephone companies.

Transfers the balance remaining at the end of FY 2014-2015 into the Overcollections Fund.

RAPID RESPONSE FUND (EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2015)

<u>Present law</u> directs the treasurer to deposit into the Rapid Response Fund sufficient funds to bring the unencumbered balance of the fund to \$10 million.

<u>Proposed law</u> deletes the reference in <u>present law</u> to the unencumbered fund balance, requiring the treasurer to annually deposit at least \$10 million into the fund.

OVERCOLLECTIONS FUND (EFFECTIVE ON GOV'S SIGNATURE)

Transfers the balance of the Telephone Company Property Assessment Relief Fund remaining at the end of FY 2014-2015 into the Overcollections Fund.

LOTTERY PROCEEDS FUND (EFFECTIVE ON GOV'S SIGNATURE)

Transfers \$ 5,900,000 from the Louisiana Lottery Corp. to the Lottery Proceeds Fund.

BUDGET STABILIZATION FUND (EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2015)

Transfers \$44,627,892 of nonrecurring revenues out of the state general fund from the Fiscal Year 2013-2014 surplus, as recognized by the Revenue Estimating Conference, to the Budget Stabilization Fund.
