Abstract: Provides certain age, residence, and domicile requirements for members elected to the Public Service Commission.

<u>Present law</u> provides for a Public Service Commission. Further provides for the commission to consist of 5 members who are qualified electors, elected from single-member districts as provided by law. <u>Proposed law</u> retains present law.

<u>Proposed law</u> adds requirements for persons elected to the Public Service Commission to be 18 years old, having lived in the state of La. for the previous 2 years, and having actually been domiciled for the previous year in the single-member district from which he seeks election, prior to election to the Public Service Commission.

<u>Present law</u> requires members to be elected at congressional elections for overlapping terms of 6 years, and requires members to take office and begin their terms on the first day of January following election. <u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u>.
