**Abstract:** Removes the requirement that the central computer monitoring system for gaming devices shall be located within the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections, state police gaming division.

<u>Present law</u> provides that all electronic gaming devices on riverboats and slots at tracks live racing facilities be monitored by a central computer which is located within the state police, gaming division.

<u>Proposed law</u> removes the requirement that the central computer be located within the state police gaming division and otherwise retains <u>present law</u>.

<u>Proposed law</u> makes technical corrections to clarify that the central computer monitoring applies to electronic gaming devices at licensed riverboats and at live racing facilities.
