Requires commercial mobile service providers and telecommunications carriers to disclose call location information to law enforcement agencies during emergency situations

<u>Proposed law</u> requires commercial mobile service providers and telecommunications carriers who are either registered to do business in Louisiana or submit to the jurisdiction thereof to annually submit their emergency contact information to the Louisiana Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections (DPS&C) to facilitate requests made by law enforcement agencies pursuant to disclose call location information. <u>Proposed law</u> requires the DPS&C to maintain a listing of the emergency contact information they receive from commercial mobile service providers and telecommunications carriers. <u>Proposed law</u> empowers the DPS&C and law enforcement agencies of this state to enforce the provisions of proposed law by allowing them to issue citations and to provide forms for citations and incident reports to other law enforcement agencies.

## **EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION**

The proposed law may result in a minimal increase in state expenditures for the creation of a database by the Office of Technology Services for the Department of Public Safety (DPS) to store telecommunications carriers emergency contact information. DPS indicates the proposed law may require approximately 40 hours of overtime at an average cost of \$32 per hour ( $$32 \times 40 = $1,280$ ) plus associated Medicare expenses ( $$1,280 \times 1.45\% = $19$ ), or a total of \$1,299 in personal services. The Legislative Fiscal Office believes that any additional IT work associated with this legislation will be incremental in nature, and that the Department can potentially accomplish these tasks utilizing existing resources and budget authority. To the extent that numerous pieces of legislation are enacted that require additional programming efforts, the Department may require additional resources.

## **REVENUE EXPLANATION**

The proposed legislation may result in an increase in self-generated revenue for the Department of Public Safety (DPS) and local funds for local law enforcement agencies as a result of issuing fines for violating the proposed legislation. It is unknown how much the fine amount will be since the proposed legislation states that DPS establish a schedule a fines for violations related to this legislation.
