1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

15 armed forces is a tangible and highly effective way of sustaining morale, improving quality

16 of life for service members and their families, and communicating to our service members

17 our vast appreciation for their dedicated and selfless service; and

18 WHEREAS, the month of May, and in particular Memorial Day, being observed this

19 year on May 25, is traditionally recognized as a time of honor and recognition of the service

20 men and women of this nation's armed forces who have given their lives protecting this

21 country's interests.

1 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby
2 commend all of the brave men and women of the United States Armed Forces; does hereby
3 recognize that their service and selfless sacrifices are vital to the future of the United States;
