OR INCREASE LF EX See Note

Redefines "mileage one-way" for purposes of the bus driver operational schedule. (gov sig)

Proposed legislation provides for changes in the operational schedule for bus drivers by revising the criteria used to define "mileage one-way" as the distance the bus travels after picking up its first authorized passenger instead of the <u>present law</u> reference to first child. Effective upon governor's signature.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

There may be an indeterminable increase in local expenditures as a result of this legislation. The bill does not define authorized passenger. Therefore, to the extent authorized passenger would extend to individuals other than a student, such as a bus attendant or an aide to a special needs student, then costs could increase. However, the school boards have the ability to control those costs through their authority to officially designate bus routes. Local school districts use a mix of state and local funding for these expenditures.

REVENUE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental revenues as a result of this measure.
