ROADS/HIGHWAYS. Designates the intersection of LA Hwy 182 and LA Hwy 358 in Opelousas as the "St. Landry Parish Memorial Intersection" and designates the US 190 bridge in Krotz Springs as the "Sal and Frank Diesi Bridge". (8/1/15)

AN ACT

1 2 To designate certain highways and bridges in the state highway system; to designate the intersection of Louisiana Highway 182 and Louisiana Highway 358 in Opelousas as 3 the "St. Landry Parish Memorial Intersection"; to designate the US 190 bridge in 4 5 Krotz Springs as the "Sal and Frank Diesi Bridge"; and to provide for related 6 matters. 7 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana: 8 Section 1. The intersection of Louisiana Highway 182 and Louisiana Highway 358 9 in Opelousas is hereby designated as the "St. Landry Parish Memorial Intersection". Section 2. The US 190 bridge crossing the Atchafalaya River near Krotz Springs is 10 11 hereby designated as the "Sal and Frank Diesi Bridge". 12 Section 3. The Department of Transportation and Development is hereby directed to 13 erect and maintain appropriate signs of these designations, limited to two signs at each location. 14
