LAW ENFORCEMENT

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Provides with respect to cellular tracking devices

<u>Proposed law</u> creates the crime of unlawful use of a cellular tracking device that mimics a cell tower providing cell phone services and downloads or copies the personal information of cell phone users. <u>Proposed law</u> makes exceptions for law enforcement and investigative officers, telecommunications employees, and FCC employees in the performance of their duties. <u>Proposed law</u> provides penalties of a fine of not more than \$3,000, imprisonment with or without hard labor for not more than two years, or both.

<u>Present law</u> provides procedures for law enforcement and investigative officers to obtain warrants from the court to use a trap and trace device or pen register. <u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and adds similar provisions for the use of cellular tracking devices.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

The proposed legislation may result in an increase in state general fund expenditures as a result of creating the crime of unlawful use of a cellular tracking device. The exact fiscal impact of the proposed legislation is indeterminable since it is unknown how many persons would be convicted of this crime. However, any offender sentenced to the custody of the Department of Public Safety and Corrections increases expenditures by \$24.39 per day per offender in local facilities. To the extent that offenders are sentenced and housed in state facilities, the cost per day per offender is \$50.75. Currently, the Department of Corrections houses 50% of state offenders at the local level and 50% at the state level.

REVENUE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on state revenues as a result of this measure. However, any revenue generated through the imposition of fines created would accrue to local government entities.
