1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 2, after "reenact" delete the remainder of the line and insert "R.S. 3 47:532.1(A)(1), (3)(a), and (6) and to enact R.S. 47:532.2 and 532.3, relative to public tag

4 agents;"

5 AMENDMENT NO. 2

6 On page 1, line 5, after "applicants;" delete the reminder of the line, delete lines 6 and 7 in 7 their entirety and insert "to provide relative to the suspension, revocation, or cancellation of 8 contracts of public tag agents; to authorize the office of motor vehicles to issue cease and

- 9 desist order to public tag agents for certain activity; and to provide for related matters."

- 11 On page 1, delete lines 9 and 10 in their entirety, and insert the following:

24	"(b) The office of motor vehicles may deny a contract to any person, natural
25	or juridical, seeking to be a public tag agent if that person has been found to be in
26	violation of any rule or regulation promulgated by the office of motor vehicles
27	pertaining to the issuance of a motor vehicle title, registration, or driver's license
28	within the two-year period prior to the date of application.

30	§532.2. Public tag agents; causes for suspension, revocation, cancellation, or
31	restrictions; reinstatement
32	A. The office of motor vehicles may suspend, revoke, cancel, or impose
33	other restrictions on any contract confected pursuant to R.S. 47:532.1 for the
34	following causes:
35	(1) Failure to remit taxes and fees collected from applicants for title
36	transfers.

1	(2) Operating as a public tag agent without a contract for each location, with
2	an expired contract, or without a valid surety bond on file with the office of motor
3	vehicles.
4	(3) Issuance of more than one temporary registration, T-Marker, to a title
5	applicant, or issuing a T-Marker without first collecting all taxes and fees.
6	(4) Operating from an unapproved location.
7	(5) Changing the ownership of the public tag agent and not reporting in
8	writing to the office of motor vehicles within thirty days from the date of such
9	change.
10	(6) Changing the officers or directors of the public tag agent and not
11	reporting in writing to the office of motor vehicles within thirty days from the date
12	of such change.
13	(7) Being a principal or accessory to the alteration of documents relevant to
14	a registration or titling transaction that results in a material injury to the public
15	records or a shortfall in the collection of taxes owed.
16	(8) The forwarding to the office of motor vehicles by a public tag agent of
17	a document relevant to a registration or titling transaction that results in a material
18	injury to the public records, or a shortfall in the collection of taxes owed when the
19	public tag agent had knowledge of facts causing such injury or shortfall, and failed
20	to disclose same to the office of motor vehicles.
21	(9) Conviction of, or entry of a plea of guilty or nolo contendere to, any
22	felony or conviction of, or entry of a plea of guilty or nolo contendere to, any
23	criminal charge an element of which is fraud.
24	(10) Fraud, deceit, or perjury in obtaining any contract perfected pursuant
25	<u>to R.S. 47:532.1.</u>
26	(11) Failure to maintain at all times during the term of the contract all
27	qualifications required by R.S. 47:532.1 or by rule adopted by the office of motor
28	vehicles.
29	(12) Any other cause the office of motor vehicles may establish through the
30	adoption of a rule.
31	B. Any person whose contract has been suspended, canceled, or revoked
32	during the effective term of the contract may request an administrative hearing to
33	review the office of motor vehicles' action. A request for administrative review shall
34	stay the action of the office of motor vehicles.
35	<u>§532.3.</u> Public tag agents; cease and desist order; injunctive relief
36	A. In addition to or in lieu of the administrative sanctions provided in R.S.
37	47:532.1, 532.2, or any rules or regulations adopted pursuant to either, and any
38	criminal sanctions otherwise provided by law, the office of motor vehicles is
39	empowered to issue an order to any person engaged in any activity, conduct, or
40	practice constituting a violation of R.S. 47:532.1, 532.2, or any rules or regulations
41 42	adopted pursuant to either, directing such person to cease and desist from such
42 43	activity, conduct, or practice. Such order shall be issued in the name of the state of
43 44	Louisiana under the official seal of the Department of Public Safety and Corrections, office of motor vehicles.
44	B. If the person to whom the office of motor vehicles directs a cease and
46	desist order does not cease and desist the proscribed activity, conduct, or practice
40	within ten days from service of such cease and desist the proscribed activity, conduct, or practice
48	office of motor vehicles may cause to issue a writ of injunction enjoining such
49	person from engaging in any activity, conduct, or practice proscribed by R.S.
50	47:532.1, 532.2, or any rules or regulations adopted pursuant to either. Such
50	proceeding shall be brought in the district court having civil jurisdiction in any parish
52	in which such person resides, or is domiciled or has his principal place of business.
53	If the person whose contract is to be suspended, revoked, canceled, or otherwise
54	restricted is a nonresident and is not domiciled within the state, such proceeding may
55	be brought in the Nineteenth Judicial District Court for the parish of East Baton
56	Rouge.
57	C. Upon a proper showing by the office of motor vehicles that such person
58	has engaged or is engaged in any activity, conduct, or practice proscribed by R.S.
59	47:532.1, 532.2, or any rules or regulations adopted pursuant to either, the court shall

1	issue a temporary restraining order restraining the person from engaging in unlawful
2	activity, conduct, or practices pending the hearing on a preliminary injunction, and
3	in due course a permanent injunction shall issue after a hearing, commanding the
4	cessation of the unlawful activity, conduct, or practice complained of, all without the
5	necessity of the office of motor vehicles having to give bond as usually required in
6	such cases.
7	D. The trial of the proceeding by injunction shall be a summary proceeding,
8	and shall be by the judge alone without a jury."
