Present law authorizes the Louisiana State Board of Medical Examiners (LSBME) to regulate the practice of physicians, psychologists, physician assistants and podiatrists. Present law authorizes the LSBME to collect certain fees at the time of application for licensure, permit, certificate or registration including an annual assessment of \$25 to be used in the identification, monitoring, assistance and procurement of treatment of those licensees suffering from substance abuse, chemical dependency, psychiatric conditions, or physical deficiencies which may interfere with their ability to practice their profession with reasonable skill ans safety. Proposed law increases the annual assessment from \$25 to \$50.

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental expenditures as a result of this measure.

REVENUE EXPLANATION

Proposed law will result in an increase in SGR revenues of approximately \$1,042,400 in FY16. Proposed law increases the fee due at application for issuance, renewal or reinstatement of any license, permit, certificate or registration. The fiscal note assumes an approximate 0.7% growth in fee collections in subsequent fiscal years.
