AN ACT

2	To authorize and provide for the transfer of certain state property; to authorize the transfer		
3	of certain state property in Calcasieu Parish; to provide for the property description;		
4	to provide for reservation of mineral rights; to provide terms and conditions; to		
5	provide an effective date; and to provide for related matters.		
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:		
7	Section 1. The commissioner of administration, notwithstanding any other provision		
8	of law to the contrary, is hereby authorized and empowered to convey, transfer, assign, lease,		
9	or deliver any interest, excluding mineral rights, the state may have to all or any portion of		
10	the following described parcel of property to William Marcantel and Sarah Marcantel:

1 Section 2. The commissioner of administration is hereby authorized to enter into 2 such agreements, covenants, conditions, and stipulations and to execute such documents as 3 necessary to properly effectuate any conveyance, transfer, assignment, lease, or delivery of 4 title, excluding mineral rights, to the property described in Section 1 of this Act, and as more 5 specifically described in any such agreements entered into and documents executed by and 6 between the commissioner of administration and William Marcantel and Sarah Marcantel, 7 in exchange of consideration proportionate to the appraised value of the property. In the 8 event that the agreement authorized by this Section is not entered into on or before 9 December 31, 2018, the authorization to convey, transfer, assign, lease, or deliver any 10 interest in that property pursuant to this Act shall terminate and be null and void on that date 11 and thereafter. 12 Section 3. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature 13 14 by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If 15 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become 16 effective on the day following such approval.

Authorizes the transfer or lease of certain state property in Calcasieu Parish <u>from</u> the division of administration <u>to</u> William Marcantel and Sarah Marcantel. Provides for the reservation of mineral rights to the state.

Provides that if the agreement is not entered into on or before Dec. 31, 2018, the authorization to enter the agreement shall terminate and be null and void on that date and thereafter.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
