MINERALS/RIGHTS-ROYALTY OR -\$300,000 GF RV See Note Page 1 of 1  
 Dedicates a certain amount of mineral revenues from oil and gas production in and around Lake Bistineau to weevil production for control of giant salvinia in the lake

Proposed law dedicates \$300,000 received by the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) from leases, bonuses, royalties, and rights-of-way on state water bottoms of Lake Bistineau, excluding water bottoms in the Loggy Bayou Wildlife Management Area, to fund weevil production as a means of controlling giant salvinia within the lake. These funds are to be deposited into the Lake Bistineau Management Account within the Conservation Fund. The account is newly created by this bill.

Effective July 1, 2015 and terminates on July 1, 2017.

**EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION**

The Department of Natural Resources (DNR) will incur minor costs to modify its systems to properly allocate mineral royalties to the new Lake Bistineau Management Account within the Conservation Fund.

Management of Lake Bistineau currently falls under the authority of the LA Department of Wildlife & Fisheries (LDWF), and this bill represents an enhancement of those services, as LDWF currently produces weevils to control giant salvinia on Lake Bistineau using monies from the Aquatic Plant Account within the Conservation Fund. To date, LDWF has spent \$205,077 in FY 15 related to weevil production. Therefore, there is no anticipated expenditure impact for LDWF.

**REVENUE EXPLANATION**

The proposed legislation dedicates \$300,000 received from leases, bonuses, royalties, and rights-of-way on state water bottoms of Lake Bistineau, excluding water bottoms in the Loggy Bayou Wildlife Management Area, to the Lake Bistineau Management Account within the statutorily dedicated Conservation Fund. DNR currently remits all mineral royalties from leases on Lake Bistineau to the state general fund.

This bill sunsets on July 1, 2017, after which all revenues received from leases, bonuses, royalties, and rights-of-way on state water bottoms of Lake Bistineau will be remitted to the state general fund.

In FY 14, DNR collected \$791,345 in mineral royalties from leases on Lake Bistineau. Currently state storage and water bottom lease revenues from Lake Bistineau total \$6,378 annually.
