 is prohibited, except as otherwise provided in this Subsection:
- 18 (1) A golf cart may be operated only upon a parish road that has been
 19 designated by a parish or a municipal street that has been designated by a
 20 municipality for use by golf cart. Upon a designation that a golf cart may be
 21 operated on a designated road or street, the responsible governmental entity shall
 22 post appropriate signage indicating that such operation is authorized.
 - (2) To cross a part of a public road or street where a golf course is constructed on both sides of the public road or street if the Department of Transportation and Development has reviewed and approved the location and design of the crossing and installed any traffic control devices needed for safety purposes.
- 27 C. A golf cart operated on a parish road or municipal street shall be equipped
 28 with efficient brakes, a reliable steering apparatus, safe tires, a rearview mirror, and
 29 red reflectorized warning devices in both the front and rear of the vehicle."
