EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental expenditures as a result of this measure.

REVENUE EXPLANATION

The proposed legislation will likely increase self-generated revenues for the Department of Agriculture & Forestry by an indeterminable amount. This bill allows the Structural Pest Control Commission to raise the maximum fee amounts for standard contract reports and wood destroying insect reports. Standard contract reports and wood destroying insect reports currently have the same maximum fee of \$8. The proposed legislation would raise the maximum fee for both reports from \$8 to \$16. The proposed legislation also repeals the minimum report fee amount of \$5 for both reports.

In FY 14, LDAF counted approximately 35,000 standard contract reports and 45,000 wood destroying insect reports, a total of 80,000 reports. Based on these figures, a maximum increase of report fees pursuant to the proposed legislation would generate approximately $$1.3 \text{ M} ($16 \times 80,000)$ from the previous maximum of $640,000, a revenue increase of $660,000. Revenue collections will only increase to the extent the Structural Pest Control Commission raises report fees.$

While the proposed legislation will give the Structural Pest Control Commission the authority to approve report fee increases, the increases will not take effect until LDAF promulgates them by administrative rule. <u>Until this occurs, the fees will remain unchanged.</u>
