**Abstract:** Provides with respect to the sale of fireworks.

<u>Present law</u> allows the sale of fireworks from June 25 through July 5 and from Dec. 15 through Jan. 1 of each year.

<u>Proposed law</u> changes the start date for the sale of fireworks <u>from</u> June 25 <u>to</u> June 16 and otherwise retains present law.

<u>Present law</u> requires that in order to sell, construct, or manufacture fireworks, a retailer or manufacturer must first obtain a retailer permit from the state fire marshal.

<u>Present law</u> prohibits the issuance of retailer permits from June 25 through July 5 and from Dec. 15 through Jan. 1 of each year.

<u>Proposed law</u> changes the dates of <u>present law</u> and prohibits the issuance of retailer permits <u>from</u> June 16 through July 5. Otherwise retains <u>present law</u>.

## Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The Committee Amendments Proposed by House Committee on Commerce to the original bill:

- 1. Restore provisions of present law applicable to retailer permit fees.
- 2. Restore the definition of "resident" as defined in present law.
