EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

There may be an increase in local fund expenditures as a result of the bill.

An official of the Marshal's office indicated that the funds generated from the bond fee will be used to purchase protective vests, update computer software and hardware, and increase security measures for the court house.

REVENUE EXPLANATION

This measure may increase local fund revenues for the Marshal of the City of Hammond by approximately \$3,000 annually.

An official with the Marshal's office indicated that 25 arrests requiring an appearance bond are made each month. With the \$10 fee increase, an additional \$250 per month could be generated, which totals an extra \$3,000 annually.
