Early voting; verification 23 A.(1)(a) The period for conducting early voting shall be from fourteen days 24 to seven days prior to any scheduled election. (b) Notwithstanding the provisions of Subparagraph (a) of this Paragraph, 25 one day shall be included in the early voting period for each holiday observed during 26 27 the early voting period pursuant to Paragraph (4) of this Subsection beginning on the 28 first day following the period described in Subparagraph (a) of this Paragraph that 29 is not a Sunday or a holiday required to be observed pursuant to Paragraph (4) of this 30 Subsection."
