Abstract: Provides that an estate representative may seek up to \$5,000 from life insurance proceeds paid to a parent of a deceased unmarried forced heir to pay for the funeral expenses of the deceased unmarried forced heir.

<u>Present law</u> provides that the proceeds of a life insurance policy are generally exempt from liability for debts of the estate.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> but adds an exception that up to \$5,000 of the proceeds of a life insurance policy paid to the parent of an unmarried adult child are not exempt from liability for the funeral expenses of the child.
