9	since 1981 for the Lady Cardinals and the seventh championship title in program history for

5	7-B Most Valuable Player, and she will continue to shine on the basketball court at McNeese
6	State University; and
7	WHEREAS, head coach Jeremy Hollier was recognized as Class B Coach of the
8	Year and District 7-B Coach of the Year; and
9	WHEREAS, it is appropriate to recognize the well-deserved title which the Lady
10	Cardinals have earned, to commend the team for the ability they have displayed, particularly
11	at the most difficult level of competition, and to express sincere and heartfelt congratulations
12	to the team members and the coaching staff for the merits earned and the sportsmanship
13	shown while achieving such a high honor for Lacassine High School.
