6	Section 1. R.S. 56:116.1(E) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
7	§116.1. Wild birds and wild quadrupeds; times and methods of taking; penalties

9	E. Bowhunters may carry on their person, while hunting with a bow, a pistol
10	no larger than a .22 caliber with snake shot or rat shot ammunition for the purposes
11	of killing snakes and rats any caliber firearm.
12	Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
13	signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
14	by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
15	vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
16	effective on the day following such approval.
