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Provides for the time period and permits regarding the sale of fireworks

<u>Present law</u> allows the sale of fireworks from June 25 through July 5 and from Dec. 15 through Jan. 1 of each year. <u>Proposed</u> law changes the start date for the sale of fireworks from June 25 to June 16 and otherwise retains present law.

<u>Present law</u> prohibits the issuance of retailer permits from June 25 through July 5 and from Dec. 15 through Jan. 1 of each year. <u>Proposed law</u> changes the dates of present law and prohibits the issuance of retailer permits from June 16 through July 5.
