<u>Present law</u> requires members of boards and commissions to annually file a financial disclosure statement to the Board of Ethics.

<u>Proposed law</u> exempts members of boards and commissions who do not receive or are eligible to receive compensation or per diem from the financial disclosure filing requirement.

<u>Proposed law</u> exempts members of boards and commissions with expenditure authority of less than \$50,000 that do not receive or are eligible to receive compensation from the financial disclosure filing requirement.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by Senate

<u>Committee Amendments Proposed by Senate Committee on Senate and Governmental</u> <u>Affairs to the original bill</u>

- 1. Adds that members of boards and commissions must not be eligible to receive compensation or per diem to be exempt from the personal financial disclosure filing requirement.
- 2. Adds members of boards or commissions with expenditure authority of less than \$50,000 that do not receive or are eligible to receive compensation or per diem to those persons exempt from the personal financial disclosure filing requirement.
