## **EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION**

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental expenditures as a result of this measure.

## **REVENUE EXPLANATION**

The proposed legislation will result in an increase in self-generated revenue for Courts of Appeal as a result of increasing certain filing fees. In FY 14 there were 4,739 civil filings among the five courts of appeal, which generated approximately \$267,000 in filing fees by all five courts. To the extent the number of filings remain constant, the increased filing fees will generate approximately \$806,000, an increase of \$540,000. The chart below details the increases in filing fees:
