16 "(b)(i) Place or cause to be placed upon or within six feet of any part of a levee 17 fronting the 17th Street, Orleans Avenue or London Avenue outfall drainage canal located in Orleans Parish not used for commercial navigation and is subject to the 18 19 control or surveillance of police juries, levee boards, municipal corporations, or other 20 authorized boards or departments any object, material, or matter of any kind or 21 character which obstructs or interferes with the safety of the levees or is an obstacle 22 to the inspection, construction, maintenance, or repair of any levee; or place or cause 23 to be placed any object, structure, material, or matter of any kind or character upon 24 any part of any land which the state or any agency or subdivision thereof may own 25 or acquire by deed, lease, servitude, charge, or otherwise, and through its authorized 26 representative, may donate, grant, or otherwise convey to the United States rights-ofway, easements, or other servitudes for the construction, improvement, or 27 28 maintenance of any flood-control structures or natural or other waterway, which may 29 obstruct or interfere with the improvement or maintenance of such waterway or use 30 of the land for flood-control purposes.

31(ii) Item (i) of this Subparagraph shall not be applied if the federal32government, including but not limited to the United States Army Corps of Engineers33or the Federal Emergency Management Agency, requires, by law or regulation, the34prohibition in Item (i) of this Subparagraph to be greater than six feet. In that event,35the prohibition in Subparagraph (1)(a) of this Subsection shall apply to any part of36a levee fronting the 17th Street, Orleans Avenue or London Avenue outfall drainage37canal located in Orleans Parish.

(b) (c) None of the provisions of this Paragraph shall apply to any structures or
 objects placed upon the land needed for flood control or waterway improvement or
 maintenance by the owner thereof, or by his lessee or licensee, or by any person,
 firm, or corporation with approval of the United States Corps of Engineers and the
 levee board or other necessary governmental authority, except that no new objects,

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works, or structures shall be placed upon riparian land burdened with the levee
servitude and on which a flood control levee or flood control structure is located,
without first obtaining a permit or letter of no objection from the levee district in
which the land is located or from the appropriate governing authority where no levee
district exists."
