FAMILY LAW EG NO IMPACT See Note Page 1 of 1 Provides for parental authority of married persons, obligations of children, parents, and other ascendants, and provisional

custody by mandate. (1/1/16)

<u>Proposed law provides</u> for revision regarding the following: (1) Parental Authority of Married Persons; (2) Obligations of Children, Parents, and Other Ascendants; and (3) Provisional Custody by Mandate. <u>Proposed law provides</u> that a married father and a mother share parental authority over their minor child(ren). <u>Proposed law provides</u> that each parent has the right and the obligation to administer the property of their unemancipated minor child(ren). <u>Proposed law provides</u> for the rights and obligations of parents who administer the property of their unemancipated minor child(ren) as well as suppresses exceptions provided in present law. <u>Proposed law provides</u> that an unemancipated minor child nor any person having parental authority over him/her may sue each other. <u>Proposed law suppresses</u> existing law regarding illegitimate children. <u>Proposed law provides</u> for venue for actions to seek court approval by parents during marriage. <u>Proposed law provides a list of the acts which a person having parental authority may perform without court approval. <u>Proposed law provides for separate rules for persons having parental authority and for tutors regarding provisional custody by mandate.</u></u>
