1	AN ACT
2	To amend and reenact R.S. 9:1110, relative to False River; to provide for a delineation of
3	the boundary between state ownership and private land ownership of the land
4	adjacent to the water body; and to provide for related matters.
5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. R.S. 9:1110 is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
7	§1110. Ownership of land adjacent to False River
8	The title of the owners of land adjacent to that body of water in Pointe
9	Coupee Parish known as False River shall extend to fifteen feet above mean sea level
10	a line delineated by an official survey completed in May, 2015, as approved by the
11	State Land Office and submitted to the False River Watershed Council. The
12	boundary line formed at fifteen feet above mean sea level delineated by said survey
13	marks the division between land owned by the state and land owned by private
14	persons along the banks of False River.

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Abstract: Provides for delineation of the line between state ownership and private ownership of the lands adjacent to False River in Pointe Coupee Parish.

<u>Present law</u> specifies that title of the owners of land adjacent to False River in Pointe Coupee Parish extends to 15 feet above mean sea level and that the boundary line formed at 15 feet

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CODING: Words in struck through type are deletions from existing law; words <u>underscored</u> are additions.

above mean sea level marks the division of the land owned by the state and the land owned by private landowners along the banks of the water body.

<u>Proposed law</u> changes that dividing line to a line delineated by an official survey completed in May, 2015, as approved by the State Land Office and submitted to the False River Watershed Council.
