Provides for election costs paid by secretary of state; governing authorities; reimbursement. (1/1/16)

<u>Proposed law</u> classifies Registrars' of Voters overtime costs related to early voting duties as an election expense for the Secretary of State which can be reimbursed by local governing authorities.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

The proposed legislation will likely lead to an increase in local expenditures with a decrease in general fund expenditures. This bill would classify overtime costs as an election expense for the Secretary of State which would be reimbursed by local governing authorities. Overtime for Registrars of Voters related to early voting runs from 4:30 PM until 6:00 PM on weekdays, and from 8:30 AM to 6:00 PM on Saturdays. The Secretary of State currently incurs this cost without reimbursement from local governing authorities.

In FY 14, Registrars' of Voters overtime costs related to early voting totaled \$547,930, with election costs totaling \$10.1 M, of which \$6.9 M was the local share reimbursed to the Secretary of State. The overall local cost share with the Registrars' of Voters overtime expenses of \$547,930 added would total approximately \$7.4 million. To the extent overtime for early voting duties is needed, the local cost share and overall cost of elections will increase.

Pursuant to this legislation, local governments must reimburse the Secretary of State to the extent that Registrars of Voters conduct early voting activities after 4:30 PM on weekdays and on Saturdays. However, the magnitude of these costs will vary annually and cannot be determined.

REVENUE EXPLANATION

The proposed legislation will lead to an increase in self-generated revenues for the Secretary of State, as it will receive greater reimbursement amounts from local governing authorities for costs associated with conducting elections. The exact reimbursement amounts will vary depending upon the type and scope of election, and therefore cannot be determined.

In FY 14, Registrars of Voters' overtime costs related to early voting activities totaled \$547,930. Pursuant to this legislation, local governing authorities would be responsible for reimbursing all Registrars of Voters overtime costs related to early voting activities to the extent they occur. These costs will vary annually. Therefore, the magnitude of the revenue impact for the Secretary of State cannot determined.
