EG SEE FISC NOTE LF EX Provides relative to firearm familiarity and safety instruction for elementary school students

Provides that each city, parish and local school board may provide age and grade appropriate classroom instruction regarding firearm accident prevention and safety to elementary school students. Such instruction shall be integrated into an existing course of study and may adopt or be based on the Eddie Eagle gunsafe accident prevention program developed by the National Rifle Association. School boards shall determine the timing and duration of such instruction

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

There will be an indeterminable impact to expenditures of local school systems if they choose to implement gun safety instruction in public schools. Districts may incur costs for the development of curriculum and appropriate instructional materials. According to the NRA website, the Eddie Eagle GunSafe Program teaches children in pre-K through third grade four important steps to take if they find a gun and was developed to be readily incorporated into existing curriculum. Materials are offered at a nominal fee and include student workbooks, an animated DVD, instructor guides, brochures and student reward stickers. Program materials are also available in Spanish. Further, the website indicates grant funding may be available in some states but is limited and available on a first come, first served basis.

Schools may use MFP funds or local funds for these expenses.
