2 On page 1, line 3, after "(E)," and before "and" insert "and 457.1"

3 AMENDMENT NO. 2

4 On page 1, line 3, after "R.S. 42:457" and before "relative" delete "and 457.1,"

5 AMENDMENT NO. 3

6 On page 1, at the end of line 4, delete the comma "," and insert "and"

7 AMENDMENT NO. 4

8 On page 1, line 5, after "employee" and before "payroll" delete the comma "," and delete  
9 "firefighter, and law enforcement"

10 AMENDMENT NO. 5

11 On page 1, line 6, after "deductions;" and before "and" insert "to provide for certain  
12 withholdings for professional law enforcement officers and firefighters;"

13 AMENDMENT NO. 6

14 On page 3, line 26, after "(E)" and before "are" insert a comma "," and insert "457.1"

15 AMENDMENT NO. 7

16 On page 4, between lines 20 and 21, insert the following:

17       §457.1. Professional law enforcement and firefighter association or union dues  
18       Any employee of the state or of any political subdivision of the state may authorize  
19 his employer to withhold from his salary a specific amount for such pay periods as may be  
20 designated, for payment of his dues to any professional state or local law enforcement or  
21 firefighter association or union which is located or is operating a chapter within the  
22 respective jurisdiction and to which the employee belongs. The employee ~~must~~ shall  
23 voluntarily execute and furnish to the employer a written and specific authorization for such  
24 deduction. Upon receipt of such authorization, and in accordance with the instructions  
25 contained therein, the employer shall begin to make such deductions. The amounts withheld  
26 shall be remitted forthwith to the organization designated by the employee. The provisions  
27 of this Section shall not apply to any employee of the local sheriff's office or parish law  
28 enforcement district."
