**Abstract:** Provides that the postsecondary education management boards, rather than the Bd. of Regents, control student admission standards at public colleges and universities.

<u>Present constitution</u> creates the Bd. of Regents to plan, coordinate, and have budgetary responsibility for all public postsecondary education. Specifically requires the board to formulate a master plan which is to include a formula for equitable distribution of funds to colleges and universities. <u>Proposed constitutional amendments</u> provides that the master plan shall not require nor shall the formula make the distribution of funds contingent on use of specific student admission standards.

<u>Present constitution</u> provides that powers of management over public colleges and universities not specifically vested in the Bd. of Regents are reserved to the management boards. <u>Proposed constitutional amendment</u> provides that the authority to set admission standards is a power reserved to the management boards.

Provides for submission of the proposed amendment to the voters at the statewide election to be held October 24, 2015.
