<u>Proposed law</u> provides that the governing authority of Rapides Parish may submit to the voters in any election held in compliance with law, a proposition to determine whether or not the business of selling alcoholic beverages in a restaurant or a liquor retailer may be conducted and licensed only within the unincorporated areas of Police Jury District B of the parish.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides for definitions, including requirements to qualify as a "restaurant" for purposes of being licensed and a "liquor retailer".

<u>Proposed law</u> provides for the language of the proposition to be voted on and provides that a majority vote cast on the proposition by the residents of the unincorporated areas will determine the issue.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that application procedures, qualifications, and all licensing and permit requirements for a restaurant "R" permit are to apply.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
