A JOINT RESOLUTION

2 Proposing to amend Article VI, Section 2 of the Constitution of Louisiana, to authorize the 3 legislature to provide, by local law, for the incorporation of any area located within 4 the boundaries of a single parish and to exclude the area from the boundaries of any 5 municipality; to provide for the effectiveness of such boundary change; to provide 6 for submission of the proposed amendment to the electors; and to provide for related 7 matters. 8 Section 1. Be it resolved by the Legislature of Louisiana, two-thirds of the members 9 elected to each house concurring, that there shall be submitted to the electors of the state of 10 Louisiana, for their approval or rejection in the manner provided by law, a proposal to 11 amend Article VI, Section 2 of the Constitution of Louisiana, to read as follows: 12 §2. Municipalities 13 Section 2.(A) The legislature shall provide by general law for the 14 incorporation, consolidation, merger, and government of municipalities. No local 15 or special law shall create a municipal corporation or amend, modify, or repeal a 16 municipal charter. However, a special legislative charter existing on the effective 17 date of this constitution may be amended, modified, or repealed by local or special 18 law.

Be it further resolved that on the official ballot to be used at the election, 7 there shall be printed a proposition, upon which the electors of the state shall be permitted 8 to vote YES or NO, to amend the Constitution of Louisiana, which proposition shall read as 9 follows: 10 Do you support an amendment to authorize the legislature to provide, by 11 local law, for the incorporation of any area located within the boundaries of 12 a single parish as a municipality within such parish and to provide for the 13 exclusion of the incorporated area from the boundaries of any existing 14 municipality? Abstract: Authorizes the legislature to provide, by local law, for the incorporation of any area located within a single parish and to change the boundaries of any municipality affected by the incorporation.

<u>Present constitution</u> provides that the legislature shall provide by general law for the incorporation, consolidation, merger, and government of municipalities. Provides that no local or special law shall create a municipal corporation, or amend, modify, or repeal a municipal charter. <u>Present constitution</u> provides, however, that a special legislative charter existing on the effective date of <u>present constitution</u> may be amended, modified, or repealed by local or special law.

<u>Proposed constitutional amendment</u> retains <u>present constitution</u> except authorizes the legislature to provide, by local law, for the incorporation of any area located within a single parish and to provide for the exclusion of the area from the boundaries of any existing municipality. Provides that such exclusion shall not be effective until the effective date of such incorporation.

Provides for submission of the proposed amendment to the voters at the statewide election to be held Oct. 24, 2015.
