2	To commend and congratulate Ethan Laine Coker of Haynesville High School in Claiborne

3	times are evident as he is a 4.0 student, a Duke TIP program medallion winner, and is
4	currently enrolled in three high school courses; and

6	perfect score on the ELA, math, and social studies portion of the iLEAP test, attained a score
7	of twenty-four on the ACT as a seventh grader, and 25/25 on the ACT Explore test as an

10	serves as his school's 4-H club president; in recognition of his outstanding participation in
11	4-H, he has received numerous parish, regional, and state awards, and has been an active

14	for four years, and he is a member of the American Boer Goat Association, the American
15	Dairy Goat Association, and the Louisiana Junior Show Circuit; and

17	Louisiana, champion showman at the Northwest District show, first in class in showmanship
18	at the LSU Ag Center Livestock show, and was top ten in the Louisiana Junior Show Circuit

21	of Louisiana who volunteers his time to raise money for St. Jude, 4-H, and the Louisiana

24	workshops, junior leader service hours, and the annual canned food drive; and
25	WHEREAS, he enjoys spending Friday nights during football season as a
