WHEREAS, through her hard work and determination, she became an eleven-time Circle of Excellence winner at a prominent Fortune 500 Company; her success in corporate America has led to several regional and national awards while providing her with experience in human resources, public speaking, recruitment, financial counseling, and management; and

WHEREAS, in 2007, Ms. Maggio began hosting single parent support groups in her home as a volunteer for her church; this volunteer effort led to the founding of The Life of a Single Mom Ministries; and

WHEREAS, the Louisiana Legislative Women's Caucus Foundation created the Women of Excellence Awards to recognize and honor extraordinary women of excellence across the state for their outstanding achievements and contributions; and
