COMMENDATIONS. Designates May 5, 2015, as Rare Disease Awareness Day in Louisiana in honor of Bailey Caroline Durham.

1	A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION
2	To designate May 5, 2015, as "Rare Disease Awareness Day" in Louisiana in honor of
3	Bailey Caroline Durham.
4	WHEREAS, the National Organization of Rare Diseases (NORD) states that a
5	disease is considered a Rare Disease if it affects less than two hundred thousand individuals;
6	and
7	WHEREAS, there are currently thirty million Americans affected by seven thousand
8	rare diseases; and
9	WHEREAS, there is an average of six hundred thousand Louisiana citizens with
10	some form of rare disease; and
11	WHEREAS, Bailey Caroline Durham was one of only one hundred ten people in the
12	world diagnosed with Ponto Cerebellar Hypoplasia, a rare neurological disorder, that
13	required constant care for Bailey twenty-four hours a day, seven days a week; and
14	WHEREAS, state law required that a registered nurse administer medication to
15	Bailey which was necessary on a daily basis; and
16	WHEREAS, Act 507 of the 2014 Regular Session by Representative Kenny Havard
17	allows the administration of this necessary medication by family care-givers and friends
18	provided they receive the training required under the Act; and

1	WHEREAS, this Act, which became known as Bailey's Law, is of immense value
2	to persons with disabilities and their families toward enhancing their well-being and quality
3	of life; and
4	WHEREAS, on October 1, 2014, Bailey left her physical body and is now dancing,
5	singing, laughing, and eating at the Lord's banquet table; and
6	WHEREAS, she will forever live on through her story, as she touched countless lives
7	and influenced more with the testimony of her struggles; and
8	WHEREAS, Bailey's smile was infectious, her eyes lit up every room she entered
9	and she has become a beacon of light and a champion for spreading awareness of this rare
10	disease.
11	THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana hereby
12	designates May 5, 2015, as "Rare Disease Awareness Day" in Louisiana in recognition of
13	the sacrifice of Bailey Caroline Durham and the efforts of her family in bringing awareness
14	of this dreaded rare disease to the citizens of our state.
15	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the
16	family of Bailey Caroline Durham.
