Abstract: Provides for 17 appointed members and eight elected members of the Committee on Appropriations. For the eight elected members, provides that one is elected from each of the BESE districts.

<u>Present House Rule</u> provides that the Committee on Appropriations is comprised of 25 members, seven elected (one each by the members residing in each congressional district, respectively) and 18 appointed by the Speaker. Of the appointed members, one of the appointed members shall be a resident of each of the Public Service Commission districts respectively, one of the appointed members shall be a resident of each of the congressional districts respectively, and six members shall be appointed from the state at large.

<u>Proposed House Rule</u> provides instead that there are 17 members appointed by the Speaker and eight elected members. Of the 17 appointed members, one shall be a resident of each of the Public Service Commission districts respectively, one shall be a resident of each of the congressional districts respectively, and the remainder shall be appointed from the state at large. Of the eight elected members, one shall be a resident of and elected by the members residing in each BESE district respectively.

Effective Nov. 21, 2015, for election purposes; effective for all purposes on Jan. 11, 2016.
